GENERAL INFORMATION

Netherurd weekends usually begin with supper on Friday evenings at 7.30pm: if you are going to arrive later we can arrange to have food kept for you. They usually finish with lunch on Sunday around 1pm.

Bed linen is supplied; please bring your own towel. All meals are included along with morning coffee and afternoon tea. There is a bar which is open after the sessions on Friday & Saturday evenings. The dress code is informal Guide wear for the weekend. There is a small shop selling a number of Netherurd souvenir items and confectionery, along with Guiding programme materials and some items of guide wear.

If you are attending a weekend organised by your County, Division or District, the programme will be based on requests made by the Unit leaders, and will be led by Scottish Trainers unless your County has made alternative arrangements.

If you are attending an open weekend, the programme will be based on your Section but will have a number of elements to suit all Leaders regardless of their experience.

If you are attending an Adviser or Scottish Team's weekend, the programme will be devised and organised according to the needs of the team.

Type of accommodation

Please note only 6 rooms are en-suite and you are likely to have to share with one or two others as the number of single rooms is limited. A limited number of ground floor rooms are available for those with restricted mobility. A lift is available to the Training rooms.

Transport

Are you able to offer any other participants in the weekend's programme a lift, or do you need transport to/from Netherurd? Please note we cannot arrange transport directly but will give all help possible to make your journey to and from Netherurd as straightforward as possible.

Scottish Funding

For 48 hour or more events, all first time visitors to Netherurd are eligible for a £10 discount and this will be applied to the fees automatically. Likewise everyone attending 48 hour events are eligible for £10 funding from the County Fund which is used to help offset the cost of attending trainings. Other help may be available from your County, Division District or Unit funds, or from 'The Travel Fund'. Nationally all New Leaders who obtain their ALQ are given a pack containing a £25.00 voucher which can be used towards the cost of accommodation.
